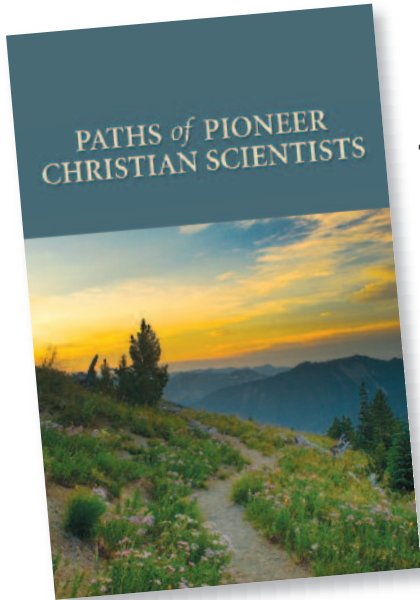

This Longyear Museum program focuses on the Museum's newest book, *Paths of Pioneer Christian Scientists*, published in December 2010. It will include a video recording of a conversation in which the book's author, Christopher Tyner, and Longyear Director • Curator Stephen Howard share discoveries that came to light during the research and writing of the book.

*Paths of Pioneer Christian Scientists* profiles four pioneering workers in the movement: Emma and Abigail Dyer Thompson, Janette Weller, and Annie M. Knott. Each one came to this new religion in the 1880s in need of healing. The healings that resulted proved to be new beginnings, as each dedicated her life to healing others.

The program will also include a brief update on the exterior restoration of the Mary Baker Eddy Historic House in Lynn, Massachusetts.
